

ERA315 European Business Law

5 ECTS

Objectives – Course description

The main objective of the course is to provide students with an understanding of the EU laws and policies which regulating the internal market of the European Union as well as of the relevant case law of the European Courts which interpret these laws and policies. Together, they constitute the regulatory framework for doing business in Europe. This course has also an emphasis on European competition law.

Learning content

Learning outcomes

At the end of the course, the students will (i) have an understanding of how to navigate into EU legal sources and how to find them, including EU case law, (ii) understand the relevant EU laws and regulations governing the EU internal market and in particular those in relation to free movement of goods, workers, services and capital and freedom of establishment (iii) understand the main rules governing EU competition in the internal market.

Methodology

Provided there are no more sanitary restrictions, the course is given on the basis of face-to-face sessions with oral Power Point presentations which explain the legal framework and case studies which give a concrete implementation of the legal framework.
